Dan is the first study saxophone tutor at the University of Cambridge, lectures on creative music at Middlesex University and was named UK music teacher of the year in 2020 and 2021.

But his classroom extends far beyond walls. Dan's YouTube channel **@danforshaw** has ignited more than seven million people with his infectious passion since 2016.

His mission is to unleash the inner musician in everyone, proving age is just a number when it comes to igniting a lifelong love of music.

Dan will be working with us on:

- 1. Releasing the power of the pentatonic scale

- 3. Releasing your inner Coltrane

There will be a focus on pop and jazz music, with some improvisation included. Playing level for the day is Grade 3 and upwards. Parts will be sent out in advance, so there's no need to worry about sight reading.
